It's been less than 6 months before the world championships.

From now on, we will send out information on the status of new coronavirus infection and immigration regulations in Japan at the beginning of every month.

The daily number of newly infected people in Japan has recently continued to be around one per million people.

Compared to the 5th wave in August, it is less than 1/100.

The Government of Japan has significantly reduced behavioral restrictions.

However, with the advent of Omicron strains, entry from abroad is currently prohibited.

The Japanese government is taking cautious measures due to the unknown infectivity of the Omicron strain and the effectiveness of the vaccine.

We hope the situation will improve.

At the time of the World Championships, we plan that all participants must use the same accommodation.

Assuming that there will be a three-day quarantine period after entering Japan, we have secured accommodation from check-in on May 24th to check-out on May 31st.

Accommodation expenses during the voluntary quarantine period will be borne by the All-Japan KUDO Federation, the organizer of the tournament.

Next, we plan to disseminate information in the first week of January next year.
