Description

Kudo Malta invites you to the 2nd European Kudo Junior Championship which will be held on 4th of February, 2024 in Malta. This tournament will be held for <u>all junior categories from U9 to U16</u>.

Kudo International Federation (KIF), represented by Jukucho Kenichi Osada, Head Director Hideaki Takahashi, Alexey Kononenko and Ryota Azuma, will supervise this Championship and conduct two-day Seminar on 2nd and 3rd of February, 2024.

Licensing of judges will take place during the tournament. <u>Only those who attended the refereeing</u> seminar are admitted.

Application

Only athletes registered with Kudo International Federation and have 10th Kyu and higher grade can apply for Camp and Championship. Filled application and entry forms must be sent to <u>info@kudomalta.com</u> and the original must be brought to the Weight-In. <u>In addition, required to send a group photo of the entire team.</u> Deadline for application and photos is <u>10th of January 2024</u>. Earlier applications are highly appreciated.

Competition outfit and protective gear

- 1. White or blue kudo uniforms ("kudogi" or "dogi").
- 2. NHG headgear, which must be secured at the back by laces in two places.
- 3. Foul cup (groin protection).
- 4. Mouth guard is highly recommended for U16 category.
- 5. KIF-approved body protector. Short-sleeved T-shirt must be worn underneath.
- 6. KIF-approved arm protectors for U9, U11, U13 and U16 age categories.
- 7. KIF-approved leg supporters (shin guards).
- 8. It is recommended to use a belt holder.

It is prohibited to put protective equipment on top of the GI. All unforeseen cases are preliminary discussed by refereeing team.

Weight-In

During the Weight-In participants of the Competition must have with themselves:

- 1. ID or certificate of birth.
- 2. Original filled Application Form.
- 3. On the day of the tournament, it is strictly necessary to have an insurance policy. Also recommended for the camp period.

Events fee

The entry fee for competition participants is €10. Lunch on the day of the tournament is free for participating athletes.

Seminars are free of charge.
