



European Junior Committee

The main purpose and aim of the Committee is facilitating development of Junior Kudo in Europe.

For this purpose, the Committee is offering the following action plan:

1. Creation of the Open Junior Events calendar. The following events can be included into the European Junior Event Calendar:
 - a. A Junior Event (tournament, camp, seminar), conducted by a National Branch and open to all European Branches can be considered as an Open Event.
 - b. Junior tournaments, camps and seminars conducted by KIF in Europe.

2. Unified documentation. In order to unify Open Events documentation, the Committee would have responsibility to prepare all necessary documents (event profile, application forms, rules, etc).

We hope that unified documentation would make easier application and participation processes as well as logistics issues. All Open Events in the Calendar should have unified documentation.

3. Creation of a list of Open Event Facilitators. Here, we would like to draw a list of skilled Kudo professionals who are ready to share their knowledge and experience with any of European Branches during Open Events.

Note: These Open Event Facilitators are not limited to junior events.

The list would highlight most advanced knowledge and experience of a person willing to facilitate Open Events.

Any European Branch can invite such person to the Open Event based on an Open Event agenda.

- d. Persons should be available for regular online meetings (Zoom or WhatsApp)
