Official Competitions:

7. Criterion date for age (Junior and Senior)

31 Dec 2024.

8. Eligibility

Competitors must be registered as a member of KIF.

As a general rule, each country or region may enter 1 team, and 2 competitors per each category can apply from 1 team.

The host country is allowed up to 4 competitors per category.

9. Gi and Equipment

(1) Adult, U19

Kudo official Gi and equipment must be worn.

However, please note the following:

Both blue and white Gis are required.

Male groin protectors, female under guards, and mouthpieces can be of any brand.

(2) U16, U13

Kudo official equipment must be worn.

However, please note the following:

Male groin protectors, female under guards, and mouthpieces can be of any brand.

Regarding the Gi, wearing the blue Kudo Gi is not mandatory.

Only the white Kudo Gi or white/blue Gi from other martial arts that are similar to the Kudo Gi may be worn.

However, the following are not permitted:

Wearing a pullover type Gi.

Wearing a blue Gi when a white Gi is required.

The official Gi and equipment will be sold by Daidojuku. If there are any changes to the usual sales methods for the Gi and equipment used in this tournament, Daidojuku will inform you accordingly. The senior categories will be divided into two groups based on age, with matches

arranged between competitors whose Physical Index (PI) difference is within 10.

Category 45+: Ages 45 and above, but below 55

Category 55+: Ages 55 and above

For the senior participation, which are categorized as Exhibition Competitions,

there will generally be no limitations on the number of participants.

16. Issuance of Visa Invitation Letters

1) Request Periods:

Requests for visa invitation letters must be made within one of the following two periods:

- Period 1: Mar 1 to Mar 31 (same period as the preliminary application)
- Period 2: Apr 15 to Apr 30
 - (please note that the final application period is from Apr 15 to May 15)
- 2) Request during Period 1:

Please request visa invitation letters during Period 1.

If an unavoidable situation occurs after the preliminary application and changes in competitors are necessary during the final application, you may request the visa invitation letter during Period 2.

However, we cannot guarantee that competitors will receive their visas by the time of the tournament if requests are made during Period 2.
