Competitors must be registered as a member of KIF.

As a general rule, each country or region may enter 1 team, and 2 competitors per each category can apply from 1 team.

The host country is allowed up to 4 competitors per category.

8. Gi and Equipment

Kudo official Gi and equipment must be worn.

However, please note the following:

Both blue and white Gis are required.

Male groin protectors, female under guards, and mouthpieces can be of any brand.

The official Gi and equipment will be sold by Daidojuku.

If there are any changes to the usual sales methods for the Gi and equipment used in this tournament, Daidojuku will inform you accordingly.
