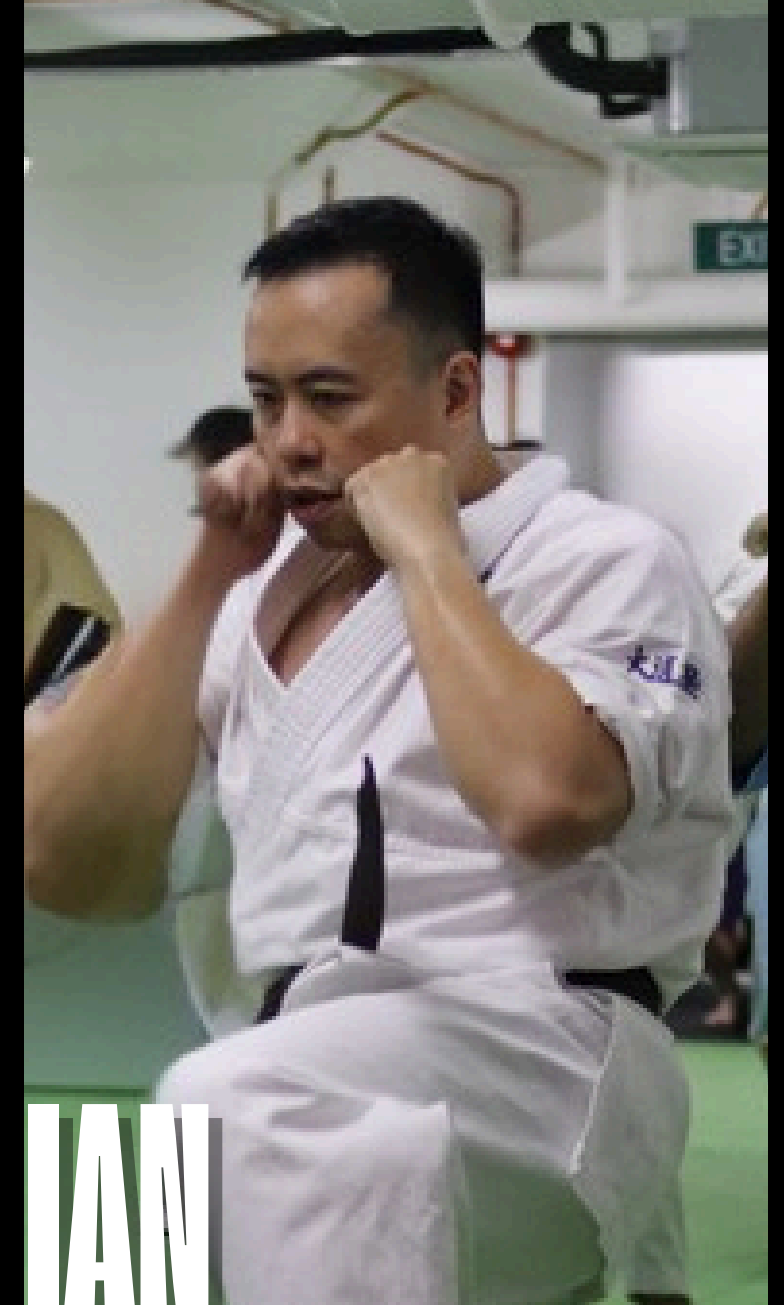

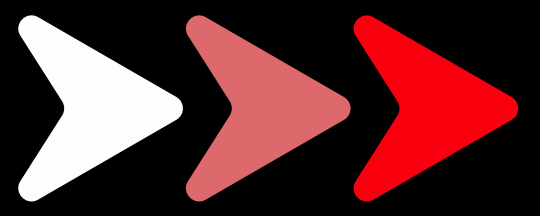
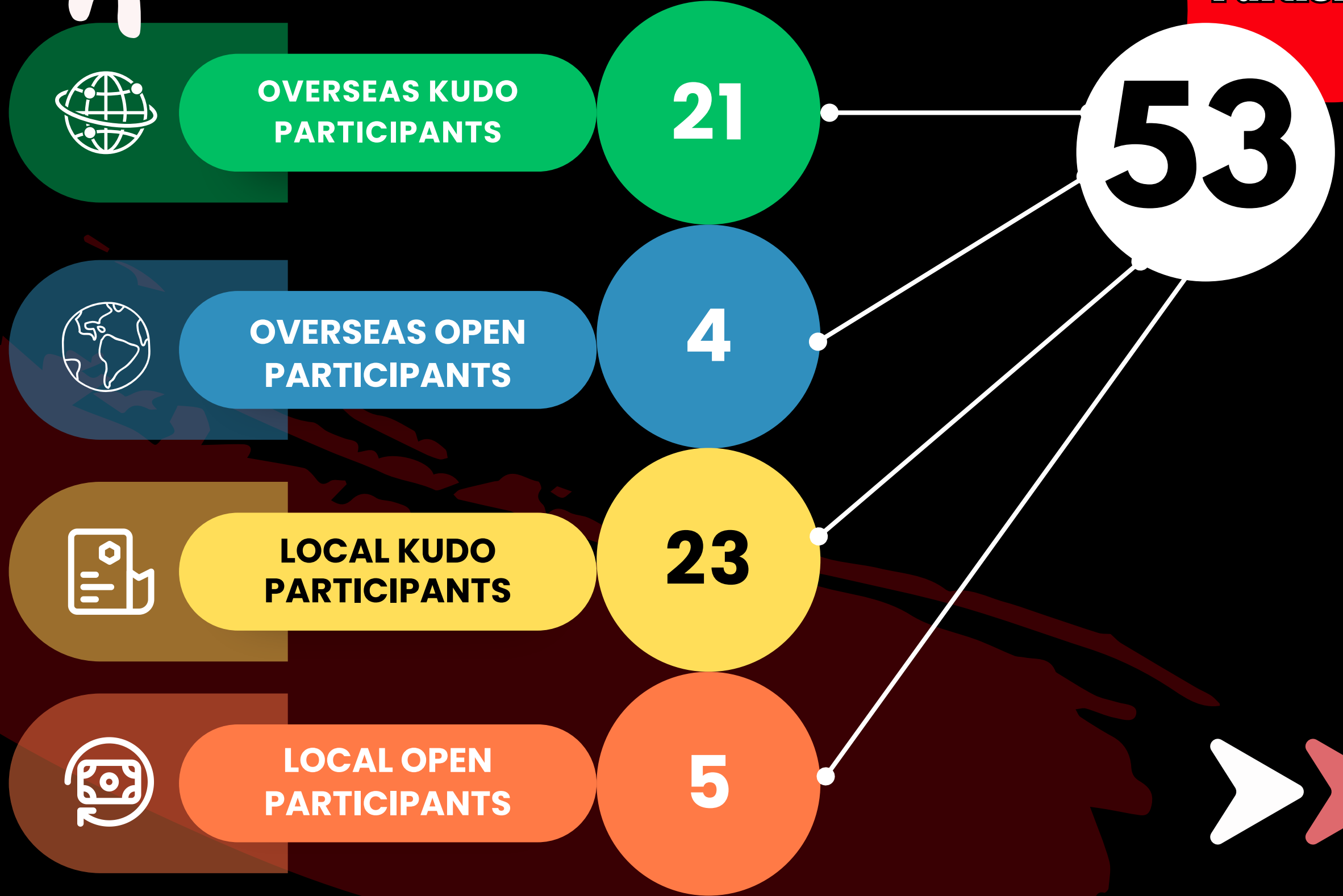




Attendance Numbers Overview

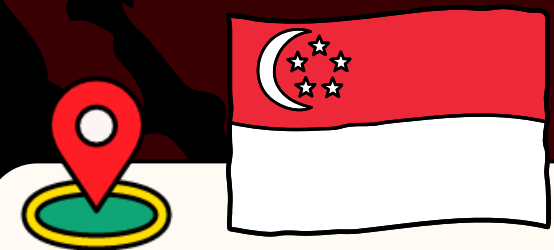

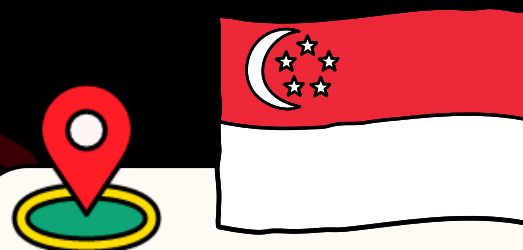
