1. Introduction

- Objective: To organize and coordinate an African Kudo Symposium in Algiers, to enhance the level of training, refereeing, passing the ranks, and exchanging experiences between the participating countries.
- Organizer: The official branch of Kudo in Algeria, under the supervision of the International Kudo Federation.
- When: November 14 to 15, 2025.
- Venue: Hamid Karmali Sports Hall, Hammamet, Algiers.

2. Regulation and supervision

- Supervisor: International Kudo Federation.
- Technical and Academic Supervision: Experts Yamazaki Junya and Matvey Myasnikov
- Participating countries: Algeria, Japan, Slovakia, Kuwait, UAE, Côté d'Ivoire.
- Number of attendees: About 100 practitioners from the different provinces of Algeria (Algiers, Ain Defla, Chlef, Tebessa, Oran, and others).

3. Logistics & Supplies

- Implementing Entities:
 - Mr. **Nadour Mazal**, Mr. **Assoud Abdel Razzak**, Mr. **Zaouchi Abdelhamid**: They are in charge of preparing the hall and the basic supplies for the Africa Symposium in Algiers.
 - Mr. Gharbi Youssef: Preparation of refereeing equipment such as banners, mattresses, tables, and others.
 - Mr. **Mamou Mohamed** and Mr. **Arifi Abdel Qader**: Support services (rest for the participants, medical support and first aid, security and hygiene, provision of water and food to the attendees throughout the duration of the seminar).
 - Translation and Language Officers: Interpretations as needed for international participants. **Sedaki Abdelhadi** (English), **Zaoushi Abdel Momen** (English and Japanese), **Ismaili Fateh** (Russian).
- Spoils and logistical support: Provision of the hall, supplies for kudos, translation services, and provision of basic services to the participants.

5. Safety and Compliance

- Compliance with local and international sports laws, health and sports safety protocols.
- Secure the sports track, wear protective equipment, and medical insurance for participants.

6. Technical and Technical Program

Key Themes:

- Technical Seminar: Developing Players' Skills, Updating Kudo Training Methods, Enhancing Physical Fitness, Defensive and Offensive Tactics.
- Arbitration Internship: International Arbitration Standards, Legal Opportunity Reading, Dispute Management, Strict Application of Laws.
- Rank Pass Exam: A formal training program and exam to pass the ranks approved by the International Kudo Federation.

Proposed Timeline:

- **Day One** (November 14, 2025):
 - Official opening, raising the Algerian national flag, welcome speech from the supervisors of the training.
 - Kickoff from 08:30 am to 12:30 pm, with filming and documenting of participants, experts and representatives of the participating countries.
 - Kudo Branches Meeting at 18:30–19:30, Comparison and Development Trends:
 - Evaluation and follow-up of the Kodo branches of African and Arab countries.
 - Structuring the African and Arab Technical Committee with the participation of personalities to develop the Kudo.
 - Inviting the officials of the chapters of the International Kudo Federation to participate in the future via Zoom in the upcoming symposium, meetings and refereeing.
 - Developed a planned programme by the African and Arab Commission for the Promotion of Kudo in Africa and the Arab World.
 - Organizing African and Arab tournaments and competitions in the future.
 - Formation of African and Arab rulers in the future.
 - Recording proposals from branch officials and recording them by the Chairman of the African and Arab Technical Committee.
- The second phase of the symposium (15:00 pm): Kudo techniques and exam preparation to pass the ranks, with the exchange of experiences between the participating countries, the closing of the symposium and the distribution of certificates, a closing ceremony and farewell of the participants.
- **Day Two** (15 November 2025): 10:00 to 13:00 dedicated to arbitration according to international arbitration standards, reading legal opportunities, managing disputes, and strictly applying laws.
- Take a short break for breakfast and take pictures, then complete the final stage of the program, exam and performance evaluation.
